## GREEN E.Th.I.Cs: Art as a driving force for change

Green E.Th.I.Cs is a European project funded by the Creative Europe 2021 programme and is being developed by an interdisciplinary partnership involving 18 partners and 64 associated partners in 12 European countries. The partners include theatre companies, universities and research centres, cultural centres, social organisations and public authorities.

Green E.Th.I.Cs aims to raise awareness about climate change and promote a transition to a more sustainable way of thinking and lifestyle, by engaging citizens as key participants in interactive cultural and artistic activities.

In addition, the organizations and partners participating in the project, are committed to adopting changes for a more sustainable production of cultural events, activities and festivals by developing, adapting and implementing the Green Protocol to reduce carbon emissions in the arts sector.

All protocols, technical prototypes and tools are adopted by the partners not only during the project, but also after its conclusion.

## >>> Green E.Th.I.Cs Live Game



All artistic groups will follow the methodology established by the University of Turin, which is leading the project. Among other innovations, this methodology highlights that, while in traditional theater the actors and the audience stand separately, in **Green E.Th.I.Cs Live Play** the stage becomes the territory and the community is the protagonist of the performance. Professionals are involved in this process to guarantee the highest quality of the actions carried out.

Audiences actively engage in critical reflection on climate change through **live performances** of the Green E.Th.I.Cs Game (GEG). The game is interactive, and multidisciplinary format, and it is based on the Game of Goose.

GEG combines proven scientific data, critical thinking, and emotional engagement of participants. Audience members participate in the creation and organization of GEG content, and actively perform alongside professional actresses and actors in high-quality artistic productions, becoming protagonists of cultural green engagement.

GEG is also being developed in a TABLETOP and ONLINE version, making it more disseminated and accessible to new audiences who do not typically benefit from cultural events.





## >>> Teatro a Pedali (pedal-powered theater)

**Teatro a Pedali (Pedal Theatre)** is a prototype that is designed to promote self-sufficiency and raise awareness of eco-sustainability and green energy. It is an electric cogeneration system consisting of a series of bicycles connected to a storage system. During LIVE performances, participants are invited to cycle to generate the energy needed for the show, turning the performance into a sustainable event with low environmental impact.



Other activities in the coming months will include performances (performances, celebrations, representation, installations, participation in game activities) that allow for public engagement, encourage participation and generate interest in local communities. The type of activity is determined based on its objective of the intervention and the needs and characteristics of the territory.

The aim is to formulate two green protocols:

- a) A Green Protocol on Sustainable Project Management, promoting an environmentally friendly way of achieving project objectives, while minimizing potential negative environmental, social and economic impacts of its implementation, and
- b) A Green Protocol for the organization and management of sustainable cultural events, taking into account the negative impact on the environment and reducing all negative impacts to the lowest possible level.

The work aims to help people overcome various challenges. It incorporates horses as a tool to support participants with and without disabilities in improving

their body language understanding, learning new responsibilities and expanding their comfort zone. It combines drama, circus along with sports and horses as tools for inclusion and has been producing musicals with mixed groups for 15 years.

## FIRST GREEN ETHICS MEETING

>>> OUR ADVENTURE BEGINS

**Green E.Th.I.Cs** adventure began almost a year ago. It took place in November 2022 in Eilon, a small medieval town in Spain. Here, among the streets and squares that tell ancient stories, the journey of the European project Green Ethics began.

**Residui Teatro** was the promoting organization in collaboration with the **Spanish Ornithological Society** (SEO) and **IES Rafael Alberti**.

This initial meeting laid the foundation for 18 organizations from 12 different countries to establish a collaboration with the aim of **raising awareness** of environmental issues among European societies through fun and engaging activities with active audience participation.

## GREEN ETHICS TURIN

## GREEN ETHICS >>> 3 DAYS FOCUSED ON PARTICIPATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

Commitment, collaboration and responsiveness: these are the keywords that best describe the three days spent in Turin by all partners of the European project **Green E.Th.I.Cs**.

18 partners led by **SCT Centra/Unito** gathered in **April 2023** to analyze the project as well as the steps that will allow them to perform **110 live performances** in public squares, 1200 theater activities and 50 workshops in ten European cities, involving approximately **45 000 people** in a large Green Culture engagement project by 2026.

In the following days, partners were able to learn about and interact with two cultural arts formats that are part of the Green Ethics project: the interactive **goose game**, created by **SCT Centre** together with **Polo del '900**, and **Mulino ad Arte** association **Cycling Powered Theatre** (energy for the theater provided by the pedaling of a bicycle).

They then began to devise some content for the **Green E.Th.I.Cs** presentations, starting with the scientific content that emerged from the TUC research at the **Polytechnic of Crete**.

This creative work continued in Crete in October 2023, when the artistic partners met to work on and finalize the Green E.Th.I.Cs performances, which will be presented in all partner countries in 2024.









#### STUDIO 7

#### Artistic partner

In 1992, director Christoph Falke founded **STUDIO 7** as an ensemble theatre to develop and explore acting techniques and its own theatrical language, which the group shares through performances and educational work. Since 2010, **STUDIO 7** has been actively working with a new generation of actors and

has implemented projects at local, regional and international levels. Since 2015, the ensemble has been running the cultural centre/culture pub "Auf der Heide", where they offer a variety of artistic and cultural programs.





### **ASTA**

Artistic partner

**ASTA** was founded at the beginning of the millennium in Covilha, a charming mountain town in the interior of Portugal.

With a transdisciplinary vocation and the desire to contribute to the development of the communities it engages with, **ASTA** continues to be involved in the production of theatrical works (70 original works, some internationally awarded) or festivals such as contraDANÇA - Dance and Movement Festival, Ciclo de Teatro. Univertário da Beira Interior [University Theater Festival, in collaboration with TeatrUBI], Street Art Festival PortasdoSol, Rede Interior - Performing Arts Network in the Interior of Portugal or ensinARTE - Theater for Schools, as well as with educational and research projects

promoted by the company.
